

Course Outline:

Ask educators to include local scholarship information/deadline dates in their class syllabus

Example: (professor could assess points for applying for a scholarship)

You will be required to apply for at least (2) academic scholarships this semester. Students can find potential scholarship opportunities through the student portal system.

A highly recommended option is to apply for a NEWH scholarship:

- *NEWH Chapter scholarship: <https://newh.org/chapter-scholarships/> (open to area within the local region of the NEWH chapter, offered annually and awarded through a local NEWH chapter event)*
- *NEWH, Inc. scholarships: <https://newh.org/available-scholarships/> (open to all students on a national/international level, offered annually and awarded at a major industry event with paid travel + lodging provided)*

-Student membership is NOT required to apply for a scholarship but it is FREE to all students + full-time educators

-Students can apply/be awarded more than once and apply for multiple scholarships
