PORTFOLIO REVIEW:

The UK chapter held its second portfolio review this summer, kindly hosted by the Kimpton Fitzroy London, a venue that mirrors the event's emphasis on creativity and innovation. The day demonstrates NEWH's unwavering commitment to fostering opportunities for the industry's future creative talent.

Before relocating back to Los Angeles, Barbara Bischoff, Director of Scholarship for NEWH UK, was joined by a distinguished panel of mentors, which included Annette Culhane (former NEWH UK Scholarship Director and Designer at Millimetre Design), Sarah Williams (Associate at Goddard Littlefair), Arun Rana (Design Director ENA for Accor Hotels), Matteo Pace (Senior Associate at HBA London), and Joey Goei–Jones (Senior Design Manager for IHG Hotels Europe). These industry experts shared their invaluable insights and advice with eager students, each aiming to refine their portfolios and sharpen their presentation skills as they prepare to step into the design industry after graduation.

The 12 participating students had the opportunity to rotate among the mentor tables, engaging in focused discussions and receiving tailored feedback. Following the review, they were treated to a guided tour of the hotel's stunning public areas, culminating in light refreshments and networking with the NEWH team, making for an inspiring and enriching experience.

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
