STEP 1 - Register online.

Fill in the information for the two participants agreeing to be available for (4) four 12-minute meetings on October 12, 2021 at 12:00-1:00 pm ET. Participants must be Principal or VP level design professionals Brand Powertalk and Senior level designer or higher responsible for specifying products for projects within the firm for the Product Powertalk.

PRODUCT POWERtalk.

After registering and agreeing to the terms of the attendance and participation you will be ready to select the vendors and manufacturers you would like to meet to review their products and services. Select at least 10 of your top choices to meet with. Your design representives will be meeting individually with each hospitality company so there will be a total of 8 meetings you will complete on behalf of your firm. Senior level design professionals and higher for these meetings NEWH wil need (3) professionally shot installations of projects you would like to share with your brand executives along with a brief overview of your firm and each project you include. This information will be shared with the brand executivies prior to the meeting..

BRAND POWERtalk.

Once you have selected your ten manufacturers you will be prompted to select your top 4 choices for Brand Professionals. You will have a total of 4 meetings and you may have up to two people participant within these meetings. Principal and VP level design professionals only for these meetings.

STEP 2 - Attend PRODUCT POWERtalk.

Log in 10 minutes prior to your first meeting and settle in with a cup of coffee or your favorite beverage.
