In addition, each year a \$7,500 international scholarship is given to one exemplary student in the recipient's honor, who has completed at least half of his/her program toward a degree in the hospitality industry, has a minimum 3.0 GPA, participated in an industry internship, and exemplifies the highest standards of professionalism and scholarship.



In her passion for travel, Feldman has climbed the Himalayas and tracked chimps in the jungles of Tanzania. Her quest for understanding different cultures has lead Feldman to extended journeys in Europe, Southeast Asia and the Middle East. Her devotion to environmental responsibility has driven her to pioneer the use of environmentally friendly materials to extend product life cycle. This dedication has been recognized throughout the industry.

I was fortunate enough to participate in the NEWH South Florida SOFHIE & Scholarship Awards Ceremony. This was an amazing opportunity to network with local vendors and design professionals. I am looking forward to volunteering for many future events to come.

BRIANNA'S STORY:

As a child, I had a vivid imagination and would spend most of my time drawing and constructing doll houses out of anything I could find around the house. Through my journey as an adolescent, I found myself questioning which career path was right for me. I was adamant about seeking a practical nine-to-five job that would offer security and flexibility. Showing much academic promise, I graduated from high school and once the question of "what's next?" was asked, I felt lost and unsure. From that point, I struggled to find an avenue that would allow me to embrace my passion for artistic expression and compliment my analytical thought process. After six years of studying at my local state college, I finally receive my "Aha!" moment. This occurred when my mother, to whom I am very close with, called to my attention that I need to spread my wings. I owe much of my accomplishments to her, as she inspired me to pursue a future in interior design.

The moment I started the Interior Architecture program at Florida International University (FIU), I felt connected to a part of myself. I had finally found a career path that would utilize my artistic abilities and even the knowledge I had gained from my previous studies of graphic design and business. Located in the heart of Miami, FIU opened my eyes to a new world of diversity and aesthetics that I never knew existed. My hometown, Port Saint Lucie, Florida did not necessarily support my natural talent and creativity, but in Miami I was surrounded by an urban culture that embraced the design industry and glorified interior environments. During the fall quarter of my first year of graduate school, I was fortunate to receive an internship opportunity from one of the junior members. It was this brief four-month period with Interior Image Group (IIG) that intensified my passion for hospitality design. I was truly blessed to work alongside Leslie Schultz, who allowed me (an introductory intern) to get involved with the design process. I learned so much about real-world projects and how they evolve into attainable spaces.

Throughout my academic career at FIU, I was able to take part in several firm tours and field trips. Having visited powerhouses such as MASS Design Group in Boston, Massachusetts and HOK in Atlanta, Georgia, my eyes were open to a sea of endless possibilities. Each of these experiences contributed to my understanding of how much depth this career offers. Not only are interior designers space planners, artists, graphic designers and, in some cases, a mediator, but also we develop environments that impact the health and wellbeing of society. I find this truly inspiring! This past June, I was also able to attend NeoCon in Chicago which was a liberating experience. Students rarely get the opportunity to sit in \$1,500.00 chairs and see exquisite showrooms of the leading furniture manufacturers which is why I thoroughly enjoyed this trip. I would not have been able to attend these excursions if FIU did not offer students travel scholarships.

I am so thankful for the opportunities I have been presented with here in Miami. To show gratitude, I strive to be an active member in my design community by participating in local events such as the NEWH SOFHIE & Scholarship Awards Ceremony, the IIDA Advocacy Meeting, and fundraising for our local IIDA chapter. In the past, I have dedicated my time to volunteer for my university. For the last three years, I have taken part in the annual Festival of the Trees (FOT) event which allows me to network with design professionals and raise money for the Interior Architecture program. In 2016, I was fortunate enough to partner with Sherwin Williams and create a sculptural interpretation of the Machine Age for which I was awarded Most Sustainable Design.

Working alongside fellow design students in a collaborative environment has allowed me to develop my communication skills and break away from my reclusive tendencies. I have been able to develop my confidence and identity as a designer. My efforts of hard work and dedication transmit into the studio environment. I value my ability to help others and offer creative solutions for any issues my fellow peers may be experiencing.

For the remainder of my academic career I will continue my journey to become a great interior designer. I have high aspirations of obtaining my LEED Green Associates Certification in addition to my WELL Certification to coincide with my passion to create environmentally conscious spaces. Upon graduation, it is my goal to return to IIG to work towards obtaining my NCIDQ license. Receiving my license will be a true milestone in my career and will allow me to seek employment with a globally recognized design firm such as Perkins+Will or Gensler. As an established designer, I would love to indulge in the processes of furniture and textile design to master my artistry. The ability to create objects that can both occupy and delineate space while uniting the concept of form and function has always fascinated me. Being an advantageous scholar, I do not see my thirst for knowledge diminishing anytime soon.

Because of this scholarship, I will be able to achieve my goals of becoming a reputable designer within the hospitality industry. Being a child of three in a single parent household, my mother has always encouraged me to follow my heart and reach a level of success defined by my own standards. Ultimately, my choice to attend college became a personal financial burden. Unfortunately, in 2016 my mother had to make the difficult decision to go on disability as a result of a preexisting health condition. This made a dramatic impact on my family. Since that time, I have never been more motivated and dedicated to achieve success. While my financial burden will be challenging, I understand that my education and the future of my family maintains a higher level of importance. I have been fortunate enough to receive financial assistance by maintaining a part-time job and with my time management skills and ability to multitask my grades have not been affected. I will continue to apply for scholarships because I understand that every bit of financial assistance helps.

The NEWH ICON of the Industry scholarship is such an esteemed honor to be awarded. Not only will it alleviate a portion of my existing student debt but also merit a level of confidence that I finally found something that I truly excel at. I will strive to maintain the integrity of the award by continuing to achieve my goals as a designer. If there is one thing I have learned about myself, it is that I continue to grow and evolve as an individual and I believe this quality will benefit my future career given the industry itself continues to evolve.
